Radharc na Mara: A modern 3 bedroom cottage with beautiful ocean views



- Radharc Na Mara, gaelic for “Ocean View”, is on a ridge location overlooking the popular village of Doolin (famed as the home of traditional Irish music). The spectacular and uninterrupted views stretch to the ocean and the famous Cliffs of Mohair
- The house has three good sized double bedrooms (one ensuite) and sleeps up to seven comfortably
- The rear of the house has the fantastic views; with the lounge, kitchen/diner and sun room all having full-height windows
- There are modern amenities throughout (including Central Heating as well as an open fire)
- Facilities:
 - 3 large bedrooms: King bed – sleeps 2, 1 triple – 1 double bed and 1 single bed – sleeps 3. 1 double bed – sleeps 2
 - 2 bathrooms (the master bedroom is ensuite)
 - A very spacious kitchen-diner with sliding doors leading to the deck and garden, with spectacular ocean views
 - A truly sunny sun-room that adjoins the kitchen
 - An open fire in the living room



Stonecutter's Cottage: A lovingly restored 150 year old Irish cottage



- Stonecutter's Cottage is one of a row of four terrace-cottages. Today these cottages are the only reminder of what was once a thriving 19th Century quarry village
- We completely restored the cottage when we bought it in 2001, keeping its original local-stone walls and traditional fireplace
- The pine-fitted kitchen is furnished with 19th century antique pine country kitchen table, bench and dresser. Antique pine chairs and wardrobes in the living room and bedroom recreate the rustic life that once was. The lounge has a traditional wood-burning stove
- Facilities:
 - 1 bedroom (Double bed and a pull-out Futon in the living room – sleeps 2-4)
 - 1 bathroom with shower
 - Kitchen Diner featuring a 19th century Irish antique pine dresser, table and school bench.
 - Living room with original exposed stone wall and hearth and large wood burning fire stove
 - Barn half doors lead out to charmingly landscaped back garden and a picnic table to dine on
 - Central Heating



Tigh Amou: A modern 4 bedroom house in the heart of Doolin Village



- Tigh Amu (Gaelic for “the house of Amu” – my sister’s married name) sits at the end of a private road surrounded by beautiful quiet countryside, yet it is only a 5 minute walk to the lively pubs in Doolin village.
- Doolin is famed as the home of traditional Irish music and its sea food restaurants. Doolin is the ferry port for the Aran Islands and a short drive from the Cliffs of Moher, the Burren and the largest Stalactite in the Northern Hemisphere
- Tigh Amu is a spacious modern Irish country home, with a kitchen-diner large enough to hold a major party! It also features an open fireplace built from Connemara marble in the living room. Both the living room and the family room have sliding doors leading out onto the garden affording lovely country views.
- Facilities
 - 4 large bedrooms (all en suite)
 - 3 double and one triple
 - A very spacious kitchen-diner
 - Spacious lounge-diner with open fire
 - Family sun room with country views
 - Utility room and separate toilet



Wishing Well: A luxurious six-bedroom house with wonderful scenic views



- The Wishing Well is a luxurious six-bedroom house in Doolin, lovely private garden with wonderful scenic views overlooking the Aran Islands and Doolin Bay. The Wishing well has a very sunny and cheerful bright position.
- The Wishing Well is situated on the Cliffs of Moher road and just two minutes' drive from the famous village of Doolin and only five minutes drive the town of Lisdoonvarna.
- The Wishing Well is a modern home built 5 years ago; but in a style which is sympathetic to the traditional homes in the area. Unusually for its position it is a two storey "Dorma" house (most homes in the area are single storey "bungalow" style homes). This really is a big house; with comfortable sleeping for 13 we often find it is rented by two families, who want to holiday together in comfort but without the expense of hotel room rates.
- Facilities
 - 6 Bedrooms (3 doubles, 1 twin, 1 treble, 1 master bedroom – king sized bed). All rooms contain hairdryers, complete sets of linen, hand/bath towels.
 - Dining room. Lounge with Sky TV/Video, leather suite, stove fire. CD. Utility room (separate toilet downstairs), Large garden. Central Heating. Ample off-road parking



All only a 75 minute drive from Shannon Airport on Ireland's West Coast



- Shannon Airport has direct flights to many European and USA cities; with low cost airlines (Aer Lingus and Ryanair) serving the UK
- Beyond the main roads the roads are quiet... but often slow with people admiring the scenery
- Doolin has a small grocery store (but excellent pubs and restaurants). The nearest real grocery shopping is in Ennistymon (20 minutes drive). Ennis (40 minutes drive) is big enough to have a Dunnes Stores (the equivalent of M&S or KMart)
- The Radharc Na Mara is easy driving distance to Lisdoonvarna (the world famous match-making festival), the Burren (an area of outstanding geology, fauna and iron age archaeology) and Lahinch (a seaside town with the World famous golf links).
- Slightly further is Galway Bay, Limerick and the Aran Islands (a 45 minute ferry from Doolin Harbour)
- Doolin and surrounding areas were the location for the filming of Man of Aran and Father Ted....
